Family History and Genealogy

As of this writing the genealogy page at Getman.org includes the first six generations of Caspar and his descendants, and the known Getman "B line" through 1930. Research is nearly completed on the Getman "C Line" and will be added as soon as it is finished.

Our research with the US census has been able to identify many of the communities our families lived in, their occupations, approximate dates of birth and many in-laws.
