

New Sections Added to Web Page "B Line"

In order to accommodate additional research and information, new sections have been added to the Getman Genealogy Web Page. The largest new section covers the known descendants of Christian Getman b. 1734. These are the folks identified in the Getman Family Genealogy as the "B Line". Persons born after 1930 have not been included.

During the research we were fortunate to have been contacted by folks researching the ancestry of Getmans who had migrated to Michigan and further west. Through this collaboration a wedding registration was discovered that confirms Aaron Getman b. 7 Nov 1794, was a son of Peter Getman and Elisabeth Richter.

Aaron GFG # A45 and Arendt GFG # B29 were the same person. The new section of the web page includes this change. Removing Aaron A-45 from the family of Frederick Getman and Mary Strayer also resolves the question of his birth two years prior to their marriage.

None of this would have been discovered were it not for questions asked as a result of the web page.

Unidentified Getmans

A section listing persons with the Getman surname who cannot be connected with our current data has been added to the Web Page. In this section we will provide the reader with the information as we have it, in hopes that someone will know more about them.

Book Reviews

Several Getmans have been authors. A section has been added to the Getman Forum to include reviews of books written by or about Getmans. You are encouraged to stop by read what others have said and add your own comments.
