The survey concerning the Association's 2008 meeting has been completed. Our appreciation is extended to all who participated.

As a result of the input we have made arrangements to gather at Fort Klock, St Johnsville, NY on Saturday August 2nd. This gathering will be in conjunction with the Klock Family Reunion and will include a number of special presentations, some 18th century re-enactors and a catered BBQ offering Pork, Rolls, Salad, Beans, and Salt Potatoes.

The cost will be \$12.00 per adult, \$9.00 for children (12-4) and under 3 is free. Any extra money goes to the fort after the reunion is over. Reservations are required prior to July 18, 2008.

A significant number of folks in the area are descended from both the Getman and Klock familes. Perhaps you are one of them.

Fort Klock

Fort Klock is located on NYS Route 5, a few miles east of Saint Johnsville, Montgomery County, New York. Like several other "forts" in the area, Fort Klock is actually a stone homestead and trading post, built in a manner which allowed it to be well defended. Residents of the area could gather with the Klocks when conflicts threatened.

Most early residents of the area were first and second generation Palatinate immigrants. Their place of worship was the St. Johns Dutch Reformed Church and later the Palatine Dutch Reformed Church. Fort Klock is situated between the two churches along the Mohawk River and the old turnpike.

In recent years the property has been revitalized as a historical site, frequently offering demonstrations and an opportunity to learn about the lives of early palatinate settlers.

Web Page to be Updated

The Getman Association web page has periodic updates of information, pictures and similar material.

Prior to the Christmas holiday the genealogical section will be updated. Included in the new material will be a large portion of the A line (descendants of George Getman b. 1723). The B and C lines are already included. Additional information includes, numerous census records and many additional Getman descendants discovered as a result of those census records.

More study is needed on this group.

If we are not able to place it at the present time, it will probably become more clear to later historians. We have been able to fill in some spaces from the material left to us by earlier historians.

Genealogy Update, December 2007

Genealogy is a curious pastime; I consider it an effort to assemble the world's largest jig saw puzzle, without a picture and endless possible pieces. It is challenging, frustrating and rewarding all at the same time. Recently the internet has generated thousands of opportunities for most researchers. Some of the data that is available is of questionable value, most is useful and all should be verified whenever possible.

One of the current criticisms of internet genealogical research is that the researcher is simply assembling information that another person has already found. I find this a weak criticism at best. Genealogy has always been the reassembly of data someone else assembled in a different way. Baptismal records were assembled by the clergy, death records by the cemetery association and the health department and so on. What the internet does is make many of those original records available to folks who would otherwise be unable to have access. We are still subject to the errors of other people and must be constantly watch for them. Example of this will be found in the census records in included for this family. This newsletter's genealogy update is a prime example of accuracy problems. The primary problems related to the husband's name. Ganesvoort de Wandelier. Very few people have had this name. My research has actually only found one, our relative. However, because it is uncommon the name is usually misspelled, and incorrectly transcribed, making the normal process of using indexes and internet searches nearly useless.

Ganesvoort de Wandelier b. 1798 married Delia Getman b. 1807 (GFG # B63). The Getman Family Genealogy identified the marriage and one child, James Ganesvoort de Wandelier. As a result of several full days of research I have pieced together a more complete picture of this family.

Before I provide the record of Ganesvoort and Delia's descendants I will provide a brief explanation of his name. De Wandelaer is a name belonging to a small number of the early Dutch settlers in Fort Orange, Later to be known as Albany, New York. Ganesvoort is also a Dutch name from the same time and area. Our subject's parents were John de Wandelaer Jr and Gerritje (Gertrude) Ganesvoort. I suspect that his given name was Ganesvoort in recognition of an important family member. Peter Ganesvoort, General, b. 1749, our subject's first cousin once removed was a hero of the Revolutionary War. He was in fact the Colonel commanding Fort Stanwix at the time of the Battle of Oriskany. While the battle was taking place his troops destroyed the Indian camps surrounding the fort, capturing much of their plunder and taking it into the fort. This action caused the Indians to lose faith in the British and return home. Without the Indian support and hearing rumors that Regulars under the command of General Benedict Arnold; British General, St Ledger left the field of battle and the campaign to divide New York was to condemned failure, leading the establishment of the United States.

When the two Dutch families were married the result was a child named Ganesvoort de Wandelaer. It is this point that our genealogy update begins. Getman Family Genealogy identification numbers reappear in the fourth generation when Leroy Kenneth Wock (a de Wandelaer descendant) married Ethel Catherine Saltsman (GFG # B673). As always, any additional information or corrections will be greatly appreciated.
